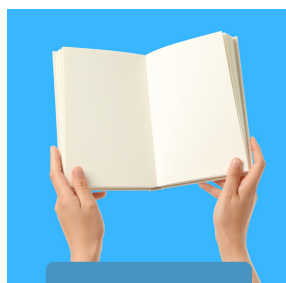
DEPART supports parents in developing essential digital skills and becoming more involved in their children's digital education.

The project focuses on information and data literacy, digital safety, online communication and collaboration, as well as safer and more responsible digital habits within families.

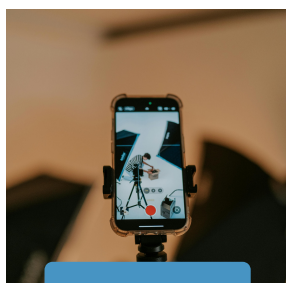


WHAT WILL DEPART CREATE?
